#### **DESCRIPTION**

Chthonic Poems is freely inspired by various forms of the great Paleolithic goddess of the sea. It is divided into three chapters, each bearing the name of a great female myth: Inanna, Eurydice and Izanami. These three myths are surprisingly similar. Each proposes a journey to the land of the dead, in the womb of the earth (chthon in ancient Greek, hence *Chtonic Poems*). This journey to death is like transvelling back to the maternal uterus just before the soul is returned to nothingness, to the space outside existence.
