DESCRIPTION

A full reading of Écorces (2011) by its author, French philosopher and art historian Georges Didi-Huberman. In the manner of a photo story, the film illustrates thought in action on the subject of the image. In his text Didi-Huberman questions, among other issues, the status of his own photographic documentation of Auschwitz-Birkenau. He also refers to the controversy surrounding the publication of his book *Images malgré tout* (2004), and the opposition from Claude Lanzmann.
