**DESCRIPTION**

To commemorate the 10th anniversary of the death of Pierre Falardeau (1946-2009), Vidéographe has made his video anthology **Falardeau\Poulin - À force de courage** available online.

Pierre Falardeau started out at Vidéographe in the early 1970s. After making his first solo creation, *Continuons le combat*, about the mythology of wrestling, he teamed up with a college friend, Julien Poulin, to make a series of rebellious and socially engaged works that addressed the war in Algeria (*À force de courage*), police training (*Le magra*), contemporary art (*Les Canadiens sont là*), and, of course, contemporary Quebec (*Speak White*, *Pea Soup*, *À mort*). These videos have stood the test of time and shed an exceptional light on the videomakers' ideas and aesthetics.
