DESCRIPTION

Using video images taken in 1999-2000, Chantal duPont revisits a difficult past, twirling it about to catch a glimpse of a future she takes charge of. She borrows Pascal Quignard's definition of karma in his book *Les Ombres errantes*: all the dreams, words, actions and intentions that weave our future body.
