

DESCRIPTION

At first sight, they would appear to live in two different worlds. He lives in Monaco, is young, brimming with health and a millionaire. Shot during the 1997 Formula 1 Grand Prix, *Le Beau Jacques* follows the parallel activities of Jacques Villeneuve and the director's two aunts, the race-car driver's greatest fans.
