

DESCRIPTION

This video is a audio-visual essay dealing with oppositions and connections surrounding the typical paradigm of hippie thought during the 70's. It first evokes the disassociation between nature and culture, and then takes us along on a couple's trip through nature described as the opposition between fire and water.
