**DESCRIPTION**

In October 2001, in the frame of *Expérience trouble* presented by the AXENÉO7 Centre of Artists, performer Sylvie Tourangeau spent ten days imagining herself in a body other than her own, in the tranquil stillness experienced by the heron, at the city of Hull's various bodies of water. Having described the project as "subversive slowness", the director wanted to capture the experience in a profoundly artistic way, in continuum with the work.
