

DESCRIPTION

A debate on the nationalist issue, with Charles Gagnon from the *En lutte* collective, Pierre Vallières, leftist thinker, and Gérald Godin, deputy for the Parti Québécois. Each man states his views in turn: for Vallières nationalist oppression is a form of capitalist oppression, but the social issue is primordial; for Godin, the nationalist issue must be solved first, since it is the key to all the other issues; Charles Gagnon acknowledges that Québec is an oppressed nation, but stresses that Canadian and Québécois workers must not be divided against their common enemy: Canadian capitalism.
